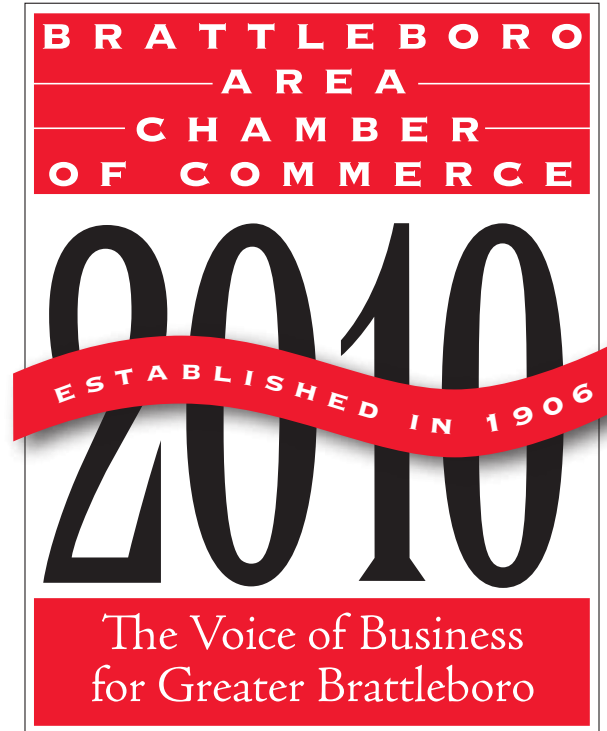

In 2009 the BACC

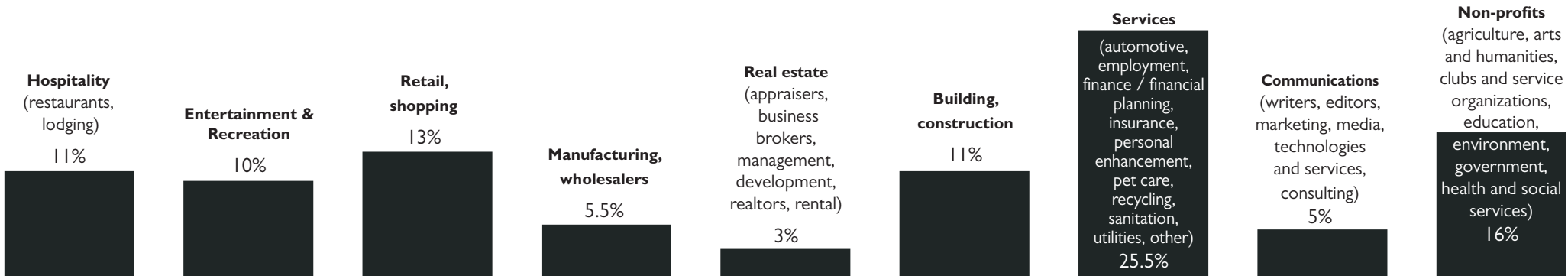
- Continued to provide affordable medical and dental insurance plans from CIGNA and Delta Dental respectively
